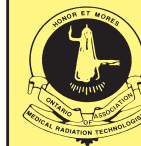

## PURPOSE



The Mrs. M.E. (Beth) Wastle Bursary was established in recognition of the former Executive Director of the Association.

This Bursary provides funds for OAMRT

Members to pursue research that expands the Medical Radiation Technologist's professional knowledge base. This will mutually benefit the individual Member's learning and development needs, as well as promoting practitioner research to benefit the Association, and Profession.

The Bursary also provides funds for individuals wishing to develop Self-Directed Learning Packages in areas that can be professionally beneficial for other OAMRT Members.

Any OAMRT Member may apply for the Bursary.

The fund provides small scale research grants in the order of \$500 - \$1,000.

## PROJECT CRITERIA

There are two areas that will be considered for funding:

### 1. Research

Research must be specific to the Profession, and should be original and of high quality.

Applications to take courses or seminars *do not* qualify for funding unless the course or seminar contains a substantial research component (such as a dissertation/thesis/written action case). In that case, funding will be considered to support the research component only.

### 2. Applications for Funding to Produce a Self-Directed Learning Package (SDLP)

Proposals other than pure research will either be in the form of a SDLP, or in a form that can easily be converted to a SDLP.

Information on the criteria of an SDLP can be obtained from OAMRT Head Office to use as a guideline for the structure of the paper. SDLPs produced by the OAMRT from papers, as well as papers designed as SDLPs, will become copyright documents of OAMRT.

## CRITERIA

- ✓ The Applicant should be prepared to invest some of their own funds.
- ✓ The Applicant should also attempt to secure funds from other sources (e.g. Employer, other research grant applications, etc.)
- ✓ The dissemination process for the research results must be provided to the Membership. (e.g. Intention to present the results at a Section meeting, publish in a peer-reviewed journal, produce an educational product for the OAMRT, etc.)
