**SUBJECT:** STUDENT STATUS - MEDICAL RADIATION TECHNOLOGY

**POSITION  
STATEMENT:**

Provincial statutes require that those persons employed to practice medical radiation technology are registered with the College of Medical Radiation Technologists of Ontario (CMRTO). It is therefore the opinion of this Association that Medical Radiation Technology Students who have not completed the C.A.M.R.T. Certification process (albeit they may have completed their Training Program) can NOT be employed as Technologists or Therapists.

**GUIDELINE:**

*(Employment)*

Stipends, grants or bursaries given to Students during their Training Program by a facility are not considered paid employment by the Association, as long as the facility clearly recognizes that the Student must be afforded appropriate supervision in accordance with the H.A.R.P. Act and its Regulations, the Basis of Accreditation for Educational Programs in Allied Medical Disciplines (CMA/CAMRT) and our Policy: STD 06-01-01 and STD 06-01-02.
